	Warm Handoff, Medication Safes and Disposal Pouches and Accidental Drug Overdose.		
	Members discussed the need to obtain real time overdose data and the variety of		
	entities that collect this data including EMS, Fire, Police and Emergency Rooms. Ms.		
	Reinhold reported there is a data subcommittee that is currently working on bringing		
	this information together. She provided the weblinks for where this information will		
	be housed:

	Members discussed the need to obtain real time data for community responses.		
	Additionally, other topics that were discussed was how to differentiate between		
	where they overdosed versus where they live, as well as other Ambulance districts		
	that may want to participate in OD Maps.		
Opiate Action Team Members discussed the need to determine communities who have coording			
Structure and Branches	overdose responses. MHARS' and LCPH Staff have been connecting with Montgomery		
	County (Dayton, OH) and determine that adapting their structure and data sharing		
	formats would be beneficial for Lorain County. The proposed structure was shared		
	with LCOAT members in June, 2019 and minor updates were made for some of the		
	branches. Members discussed the value of ensuring that the Faith Leaders Roundtable		
	continues. Members discussed the need to include the Stigma of Addiction in the		
	Education and Information Branch. LCOAT members are asked to provide input		
	regarding each of the branches to help get community stakeholders involved. The		
	work document will be sent out to LCOAT members for their response in the coming

	Software. Ms. Robinson indicated the need to align the work of LCOAT with this		
	priority.
